Nursery Class Newsletter Autumn 2

Welcome back to our second half term. It has been wonderful to see how happy the children have been to return to school and how well they have settled back in to the Nursery routine.

Our topic this half term is 'Celebrations' and we have lots of exciting activities planned for the next few weeks. We are looking forward to discussing the different celebrations the children take part in at home during this time of year such as Halloween, Bonfire night, Diwali, Chanukah, Christmas, and of course how we celebrate our birthdays. We have also been learning about 2D shapes, finding them in ice, cornflour 'ooblek', shaving foam or playdough and trying to spot different shapes in our school environment.

For much of the day, the children will be playing, socialising and learning independently both outside and inside the classrooms. During each session the children will take part in a 'carpet time', listening to and discussing a variety of themed stories, practising skills, learning new songs and engaging in whole group activities such as singing, dancing and parachute games.
