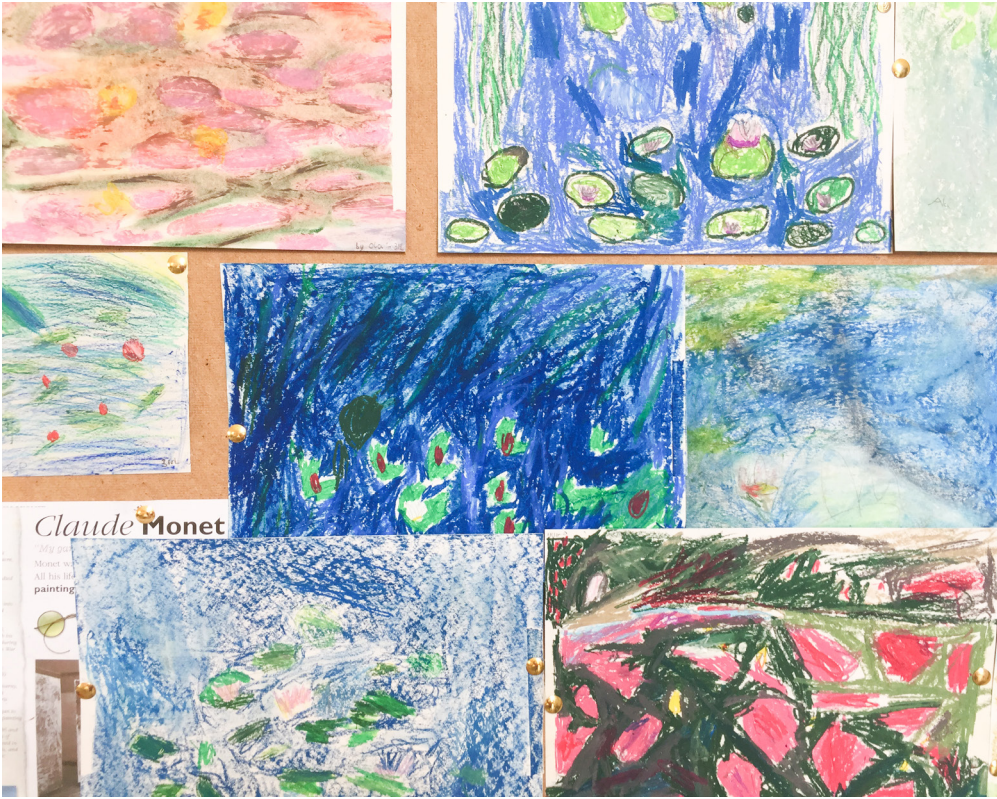


The sun shined, the seeds grew and the art room was busy;

On the 16th of May, the total lunar eclipse took place during **The Sketch Club**. Working with mixed media we were able to capture this spectacular moment.



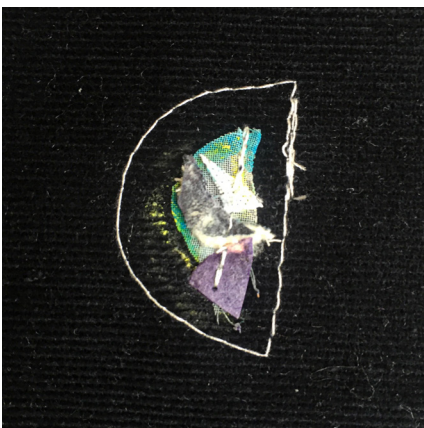
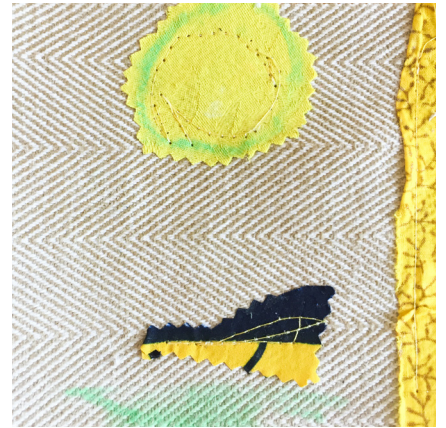
Also, **The Sketch Club** enjoyed the Summer 1 weather in the Peace Garden. Real nature was the inspiration for the Whittington hospital project.

Inspired by 'the Sky'

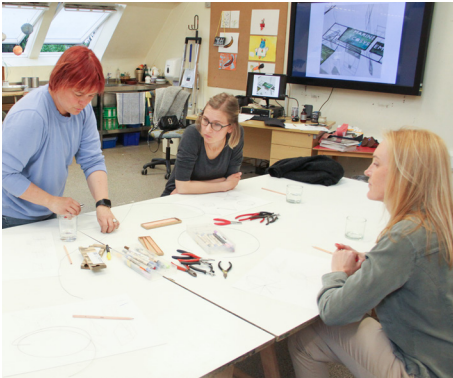
Reception, Year 1, and the entire **Blanche Neville School** brought the sun, the moon and the rainbow into the project, with imaginative perspectives of the sky.
