<p><u>Belief and Practice</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recognise the Bible as split into Old and New Testaments Recognise the New Testament as focusing on the story and teachings of Jesus. Understand who Jesus was, and that Christians believe he was the son of God, or God incarnate Learn the core teachings of Jesus: belief in him and love towards others. <p><u>Christian Stories</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Good Samaritan The feeding of the 5000 <p><u>Christian Festivals</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Harvest Festival: Know that Harvest celebrates gifts from the world (creation) and is an opportunity to reflect give thanks. 	<p><u>Belief and Practice</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Investigate the Christian place of worship and symbols used in worship Understand the structure of leadership of major Christian denominations <p><u>Christian Stories</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The birth of Jesus <p><u>Christian Festivals</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore the significance of Christmas and symbols used: angels, star, decorations Understand that Advent is a season of preparation before Christmas. <p><u>Key Vocabulary</u> Christmas, Advent, birth, wreath, denomination, cathedral, bishop, pope, Roman Catholic, Protestant, Reformation</p>	<p><u>Belief and Practice</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Retell Christian creation stories, focusing on Adam and Eve, and connect them to the role of Jesus for Christians as a saviour Understand that some Christians view these stories and factual and others view them as myths or metaphors. Recognise Christian Baptism as an initiation, and understand the role of water as symbolically cleansing <p><u>Christian Stories</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Genesis 2 - Adam and Eve Three Epiphany Miracles Revealed Jesus as special (Godly): The three wise men (guided by a Star) visited with symbolic gifts. The Baptism of Jesus (The voice of God appeared as a dove coming from Heaven) The Wedding at Cana 	<p><u>Belief and Practice</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Know the significance for Christians of the resurrection of Jesus from the dead Understand the belief that Jesus was put to death as a sacrifice for humankind Recognise the cross as a primary Christian symbol Understand the ritual and symbolism of communion, and that bread and wine represent the body and blood of Jesus. Examine Christian ideas and ceremonies relating to death <p><u>Christian Stories</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Easter Story <p><u>Christian Festivals</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explore Easter as a commemoration of the death and resurrection of Jesus, and understand that it and Christmas are the two primary Christian festivals. 	<p><u>Belief and Practice</u></p> <p>Learn about Christian Pilgrimages:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Canterbury Rome The Holy Land 	<p><u>Visit St Mary's Church in Stoke by Nayland visit</u></p> <p><u>Learn about:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The architectural features of a church How stories are depicted in stained glass windows

<p><u>Context</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know that Old Testament stories and teachings are shared by the Jewish and Muslim Faiths • ...and therefore Jewish stories from Year 4 are also Christian and Muslim stories. • Know where Jesus lived, in Judea (modern-day Israel/Palestine) and that he lived as a Jewish person. • Know that Jesus is also revered in Islam, but is not seen as son of God • Understand that the Harvest is celebrated by many faiths across the world. <p><u>Key Vocabulary</u> Parable, Bible, salvation, saviour, incarnation,</p>	<p><u>Visit</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All Saints Church, Highgate 	<p>(Jesus turned water into wine</p> <p><u>Christian Festivals</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recognise Epiphany as a series of events that revealed Jesus as the son of God. <p><u>Context</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Know that the Old Testament creation story is shared by Jews and Muslims. • Find the River Jordan on a map. • Think about the role of water in other ceremonies eg. Hindu <p><u>Key Vocabulary</u> Epiphany, divine, baptise, creation, myth</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand that Lent is a time of preparation for Easter, and some Christians observe by fasting or giving up indulgences <p><u>Context</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make connections between the ancient Jewish traditions of sacrifice, and the death of Jesus as a sacrifice • Know that Holy Week and Easter take place at the same time as the Jewish festival of Pesach (Passover) • Think about the use of a Lamb as a metaphor for Jesus • Analyse other symbols of Easter and their meanings, eg. Eggs • Draw parallels between Lent and Advent <p><u>Key Vocabulary</u> Resurrection, crucifixion, sacrifice, Good Friday, communion</p> <p><u>Visit</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Highgate Cemetery 		
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
