Dear Parents,

We would like to offer a warm welcome to all the new children and families who have joined us this term, and welcome back to those who were with us last year. Our new children have been busy exploring the environment and are settling in very well. It has been lovely to see the positive way our returning children have adapted to the change too, with many helping hands being offered around the classroom. It is essential that every child feels happy, safe and secure in our care, so we hope to work closely with you to ensure the best possible start to the year.

Drop off and pick up

The main Nursery gate on Gaskell Road opens at 9.00am and again at 12.30pm for the start of each session. We will open again for home time at 3.25pm which will also allow those of you with siblings in older year groups to be prompt.

Home Toys

We understand that some children like to bring in a toy to help them feel settled during this transitionary period. We will of course do our best to look after these, but please try to keep the more precious ones at home as we wouldn't want them to get lost or broken. Once your child is settled, the toy is often discarded, at which point we will aim to put them back in their bags for safekeeping.

Meetings with parents

We know how important it is to work together with parents to support each child's positive experience and learning. As such, we are always happy to discuss any concerns, achievements, milestones etc informally with you at the beginning or end of each session. There will be more formal parent consultations later this term, however if you feel you might need a longer chat at anytime please don't hesitate to ask.

Drinks and snacks

School provides fresh fruit or vegetables each day and the children always have access to cups and jugs of water and milk, so there is no need for snacks from home.



Absence

If your child is unwell, please phone the school office in the morning and they will let us know.

Clothes

We will go outside whatever the weather and the children love messy play, so please dress your child appropriately. A spare bag of clothing with your child's name on it is always useful in case they need to change.

Staff

The nursery team comprises Luke, Susie, Geri and Cynthia, albeit not all at the same time! One of the team stays with the children over lunchtime, and Geri runs our 'Early Birds' before-school provision. Cynthia also joins the children at lunch and remains with those who are staying on for the Night Owls after-school club.
