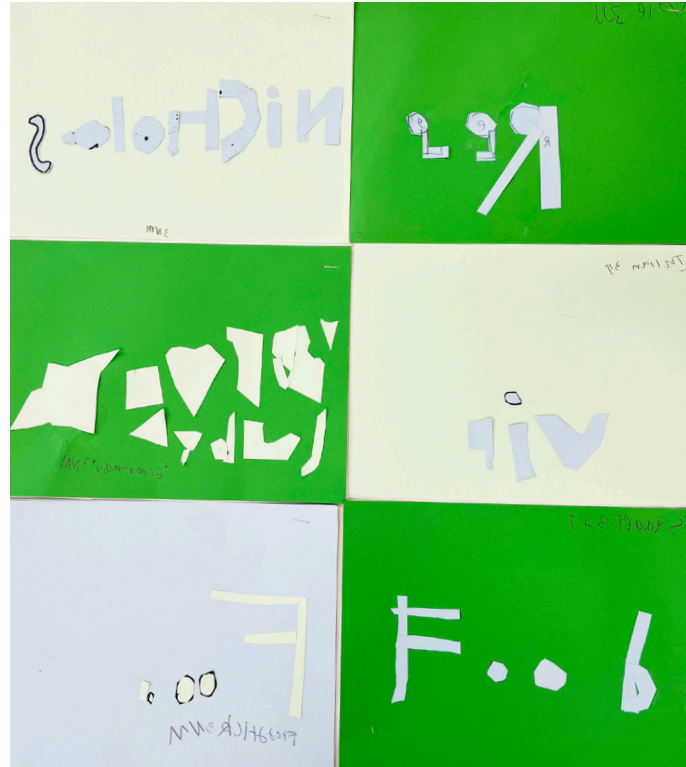

Understanding the elements of Tudor houses, Year 2 made their own creations. From planning to building, the houses were ready to be burned like in the Fire of London.

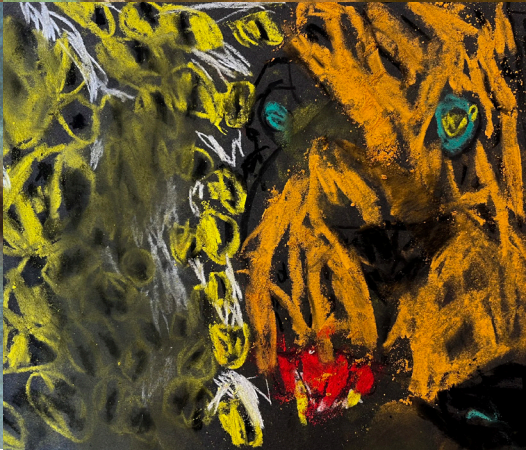
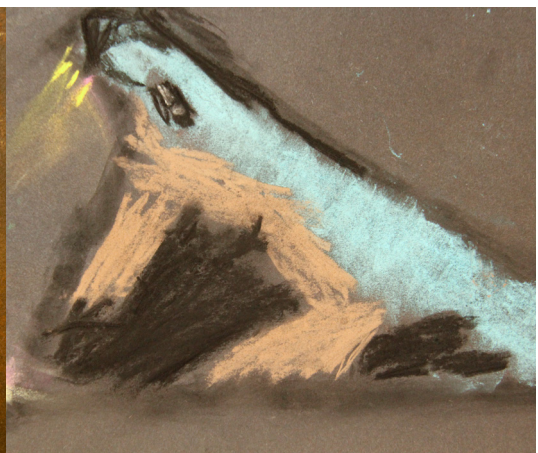
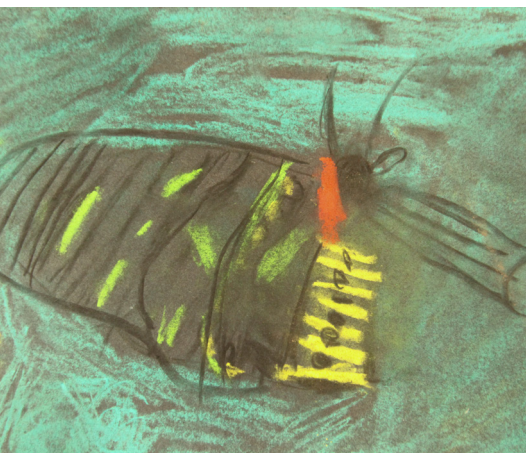

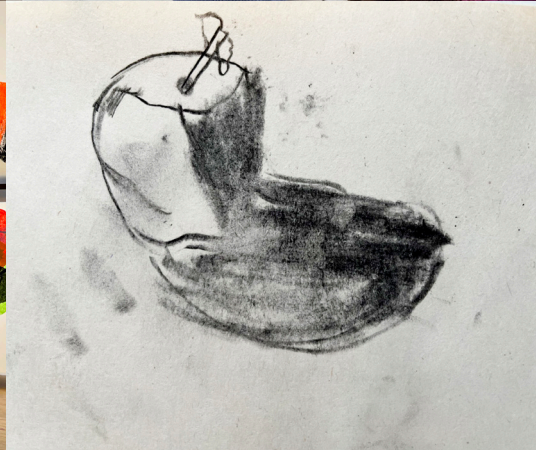
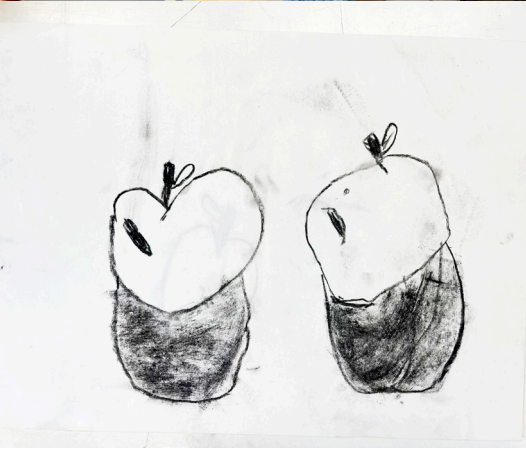
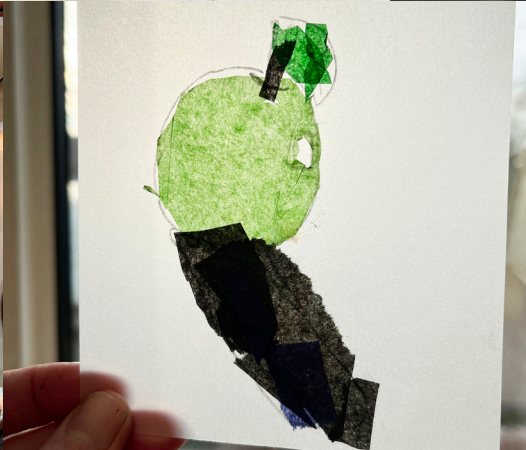
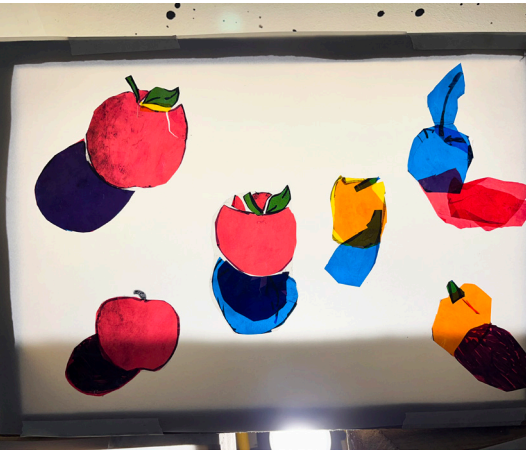
A celebration of the rain forest, exploring soft pastels and the diversity of animals with spectacular results.

The art room were involved with the creation of props for the Beowulf performance. These added to the atmosphere of this original and compelling theatrical composition.



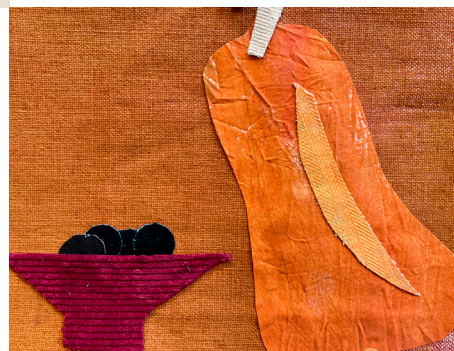
MARY POPPINS PERFORMANCE SCHOOL PROJECT
